Parental Role in Student Success

Parental involvement is crucial in reinforcing school policies and fostering student success. Parents are expected to:

- Ensure students attend school regularly and punctually.
- Provide updated contact and emergency information.
- Attend parent-teacher meetings and scheduled conferences.
- Communicate effectively with school staff regarding student progress.
- Submit necessary absence or tardy notes when applicable.

The school counselor is available to support students and parents. Parents are encouraged to schedule sessions with the counselor for guidance and intervention when needed.

Updating Student Information:

It is essential for parents to promptly update the school in writing regarding any changes in:

- Address
- Phone numbers (home, work, or mobile)
- Legal name
- Emergency contact details

School Supply List

Each grade's school supply list is posted in the student weekly plan and schools' website for easy reference.

Personal Belongings Policy

To prevent loss or damage, students must not bring valuable personal items to school, including:

- Electronic devices (phones, tablets, smartwatches, etc.)
- Toys or collectible items
- Jewelry or large sums of money

Additionally, students are not allowed to buy, sell, or trade personal items at school or on the bus.

The school is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property. Parents are encouraged to label students' belongings, including clothing, backpacks, and lunch boxes. A Lost and Found area is available for misplaced items.



Cell Phone Policy

Mobile phones are strictly prohibited on school premises.

School Rules & Regulations

1. Academic Expectations

- If a student scores below the satisfactory level on placement tests, parents must take responsibility for their child's academic improvement throughout the school year.

2. Student Dismissal Policy

- The school reserves the right to dismiss a student without financial or academic obligations under the following conditions:
 - Persistent misbehavior or disrespect toward school staff or peers.
 - Consistently poor academic performance due to student or parental negligence.
 - Learning disabilities, hyperactivity, or attention disorders that significantly disrupt the learning environment and require specialized intervention beyond the school's resources.
 - Failure to submit required student records for enrollment.

3. Student Transfer Policy

- If a student transfers to another school during the academic year, their school file will not be released until all outstanding fees are paid in full.

4. Late Student Pickup Policy

- If a student is not picked up on time, the school will notify the guardian.
- If late pickups occur three times within a single term, the school reserves the right to take disciplinary action, including potential dismissal.
- If a student remains at school 45 minutes after dismissal on multiple occasions without valid reasons, the guardian will be required to sign a commitment form, and the student will be referred to the school counselor.

5. Class Section Assignments

- The school administration reserves the right to reassign students to different sections if deemed necessary for the benefit of both the student and the overall school community.
